Nationwide Crime Analysis
February
2021 vs 2020

Preliminary figures for February 2021 indicate that major crimes decreased by 23% with 319 cases, compared to 413 in 2020. Crimes against the person increased by 8% with 70 incidents, compared to 65 in 2020. Property crimes decreased by 28% with 249 incidents, compared to 348 in 2020. There were regional decreases in New Providence and the Grand Bahama District at rates of 23% and 33% respectively when compared to 2020.

Homicides increased by 50% with 12 incidents, compared to 8 over the same period in 2020. There were 10 murders in New Providence, 1 in Grand Bahama and 1 in the Eleuthera Division. The murder solvency rate for the period stands at 75%. Victims between the ages of 18 and 35 represented 58% of all homicides. Based on preliminary figures, homicides were more likely to occur on a Monday than any other day of the week. Homicides were more prevalent in the **Southern Division** which accounted for 33% of the overall total. Fatal gunshot wound was the leading cause of death for homicides accounting for 8 incidents.

Armed robberies decreased by 24% with 25 incidents, compared to 33 over the same period in 2020. **Armed robberies** occurred mostly between the hours of 6pm and 10pm. Based on preliminary figures, armed robberies were more likely to occur on a Saturday than any other day of the week. Armed robberies were more prevalent in the **South Central Division** which accounted for 32% of the overall total. Most armed robberies occurred on the streets with business establishments close behind. Firearms continue to be the weapon of choice for the commission of armed robberies. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 62%, compared to female victims at 38%.

Robberies increased by 83% with 11 incidents, compared to 6 over the same period in 2020. Robberies occurred mostly between the hours of 6pm and 8pm. Based on preliminary figures, robberies were more likely to occur on a Wednesday than any other day of the week. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 81%, compared to female victims at 19%.

Stolen vehicles decreased by 23% with 27 incidents, compared to 35 over the same period in 2020. **Hondas** and **Nissans** were the most targeted vehicles of choice representing 37% and 30% respectively. Honda Accord, Honda CR-V, Nissan Bluebird and Nissan Cube vehicles were the predominant models stolen. Residences were the most targeted locations and the **Eastern Division** accounted for the majority of stolen vehicles at 19%. Twenty-two percent of stolen vehicles in February 2021 were recovered.

Stealing from vehicles decreased by 21% with 52 incidents, compared to 66 over the same period in 2020. The most frequent items stolen included wallets/purse, electronics and power tools. Nissan Notes, Cubes and Honda Accords were the most targeted vehicles for this crime. Based on preliminary figures, stealing from vehicles were more likely to occur on a Sunday or Tuesday than any other day of the week. Stealing from vehicle cases were more prevalent in the **Southwestern Division** which accounted for 15% of the overall total for the month.

Housebreakings decreased by 17% with 60 incidents, compared to 72 over the same period in 2020. **New Providence District** accounted for 41 or 68% of all housebreakings, most of which occurred in the **Southwestern Division**. **Grand Bahama including Abaco and Bimini** accounted for 11 or 18% of housebreakings. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 14%, most of which occurred in Eleuthera with 3 incidents.

For the period in review, a total of 26 **firearms** and 432 rounds of ammunition were discovered and/or seized throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result, 23 persons were charged with possession of illegal firearms. Additionally, **ShotSpotter** detected a total of 103 gunshot incidents, consisting of 75 multiple shots and 28 single shot incidents, totaling 365 rounds discharged.

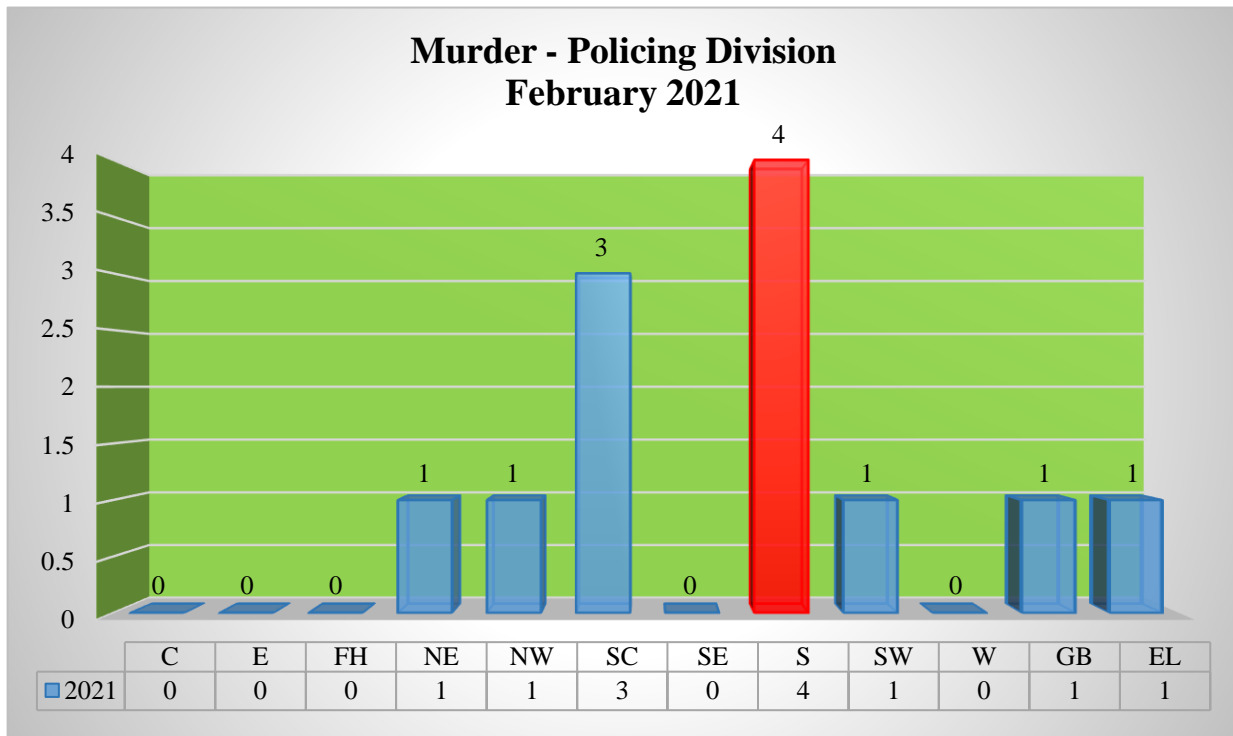
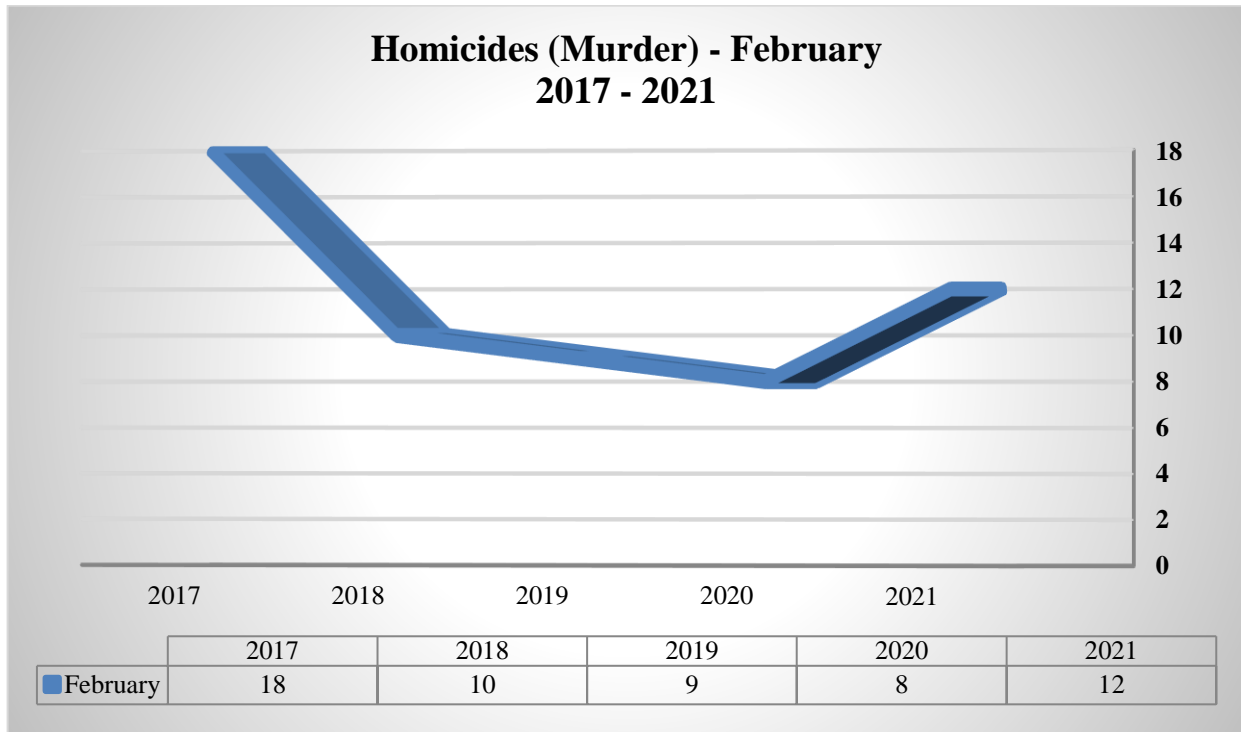
There were 269 breaches to the Emergency Powers Order including 106 curfew violations and 163 other breaches. Furthermore, officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force conducted 937 field check patrols, 100 road checks and executed 91 warrants of arrest throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result of these efforts, 160 persons were arrested and 124 suspects were charged for possession of dangerous drugs.

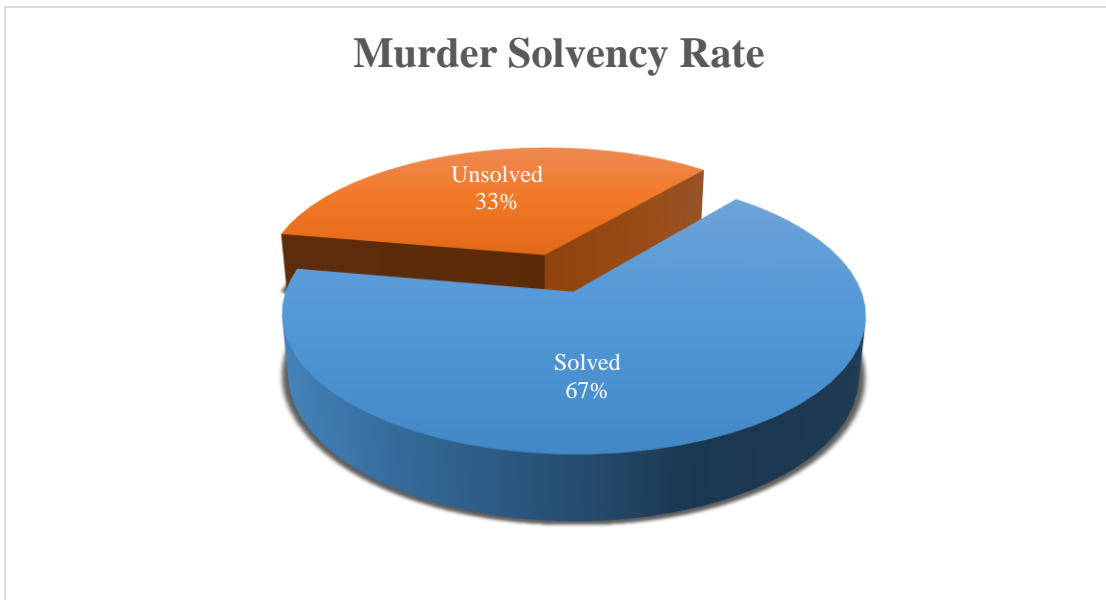
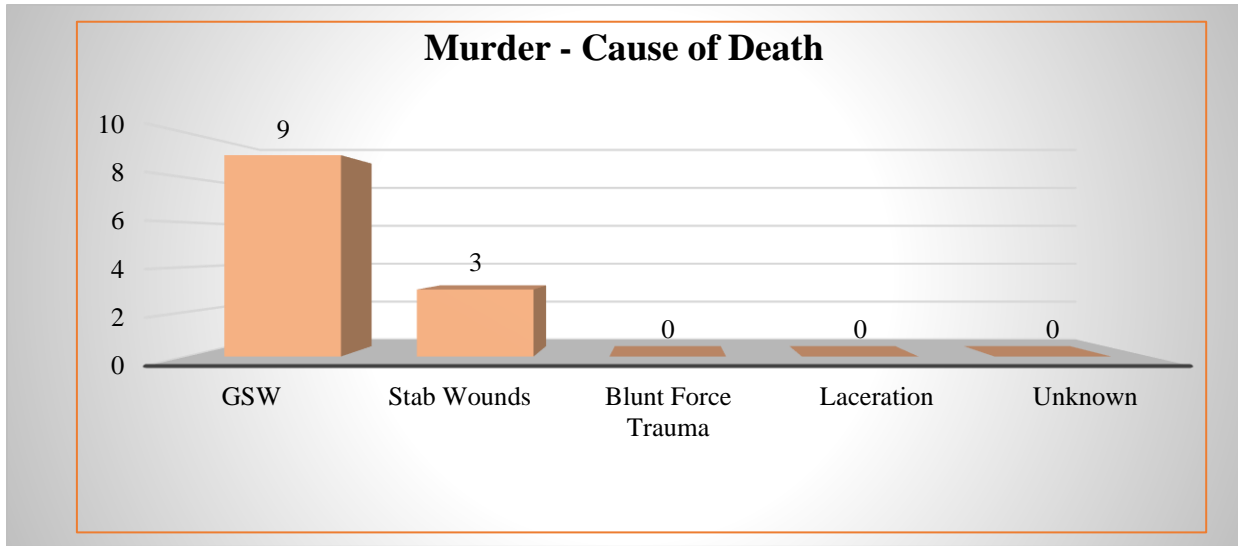
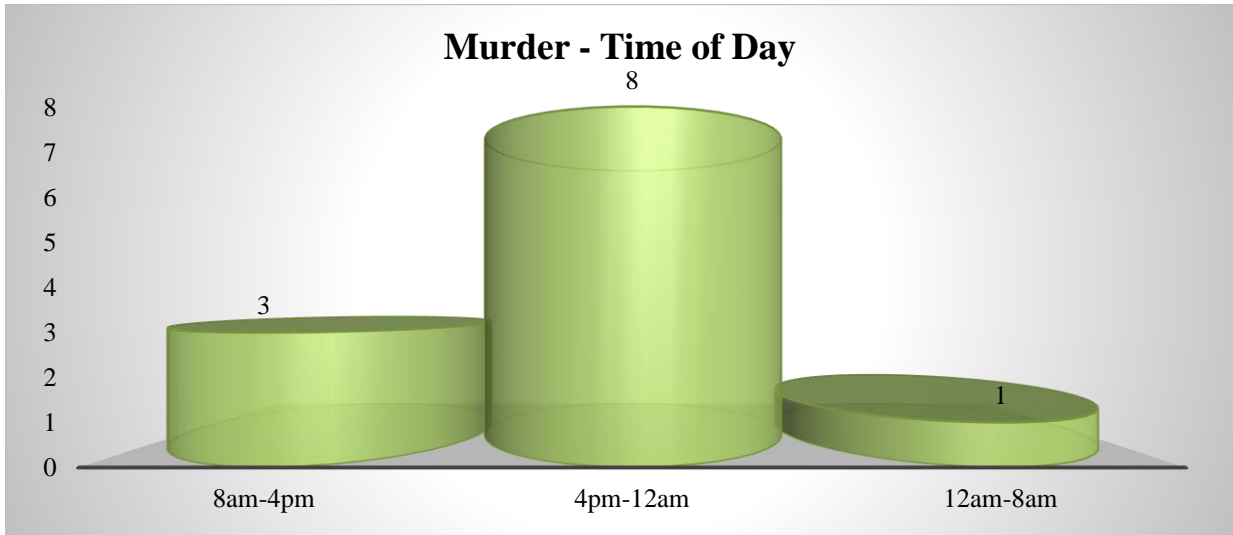

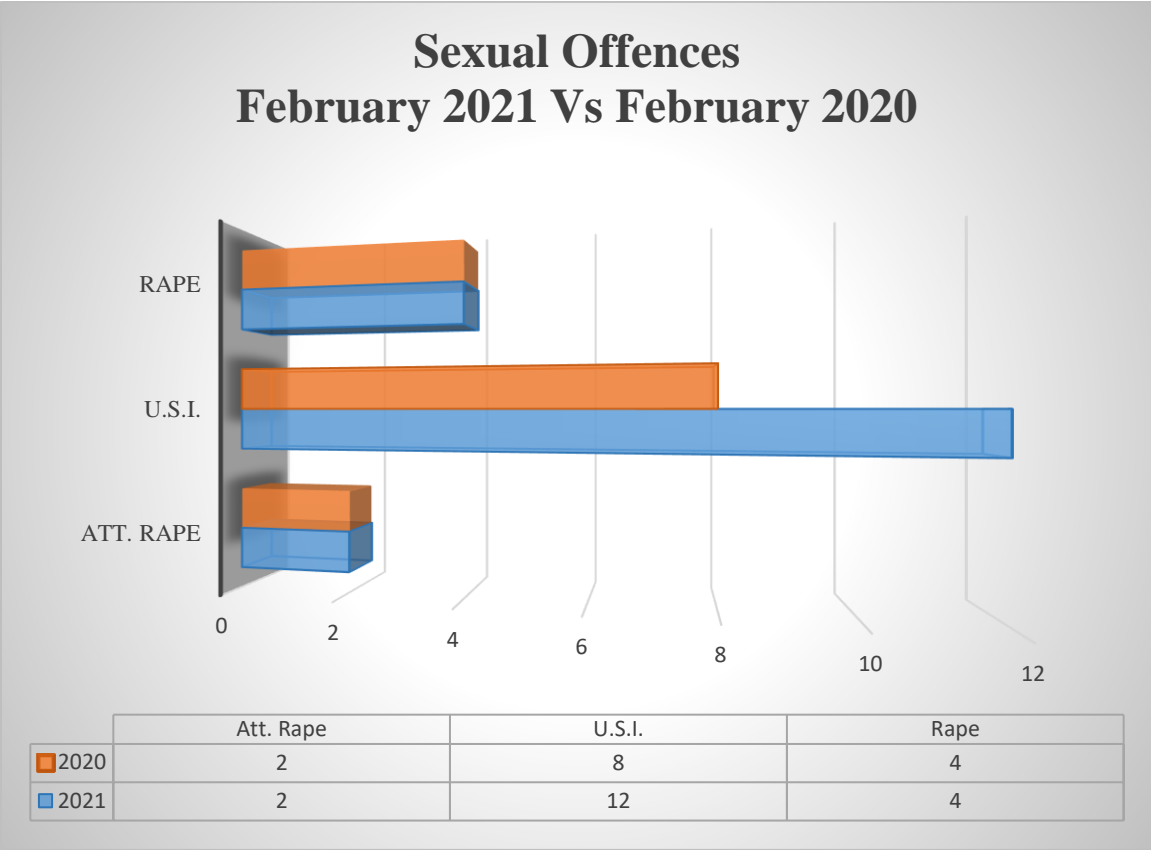
In 2021, murders for January increased by 50% with 12 cases compared to 8 over the same period in 2020.





Sexual Offences

For the month of February 2021, reports of sexual offences increased by 29% with 18 incidents, compared to 14 over the same period 2020. These offences include rape, unlawful sexual intercourse and attempted rape. Investigators have noted a recent trend in sexual offences cases where women are targeted whilst walking alone on sparsely populated streets in the evenings. (N.B. Unlawful sexual intercourse includes incest).

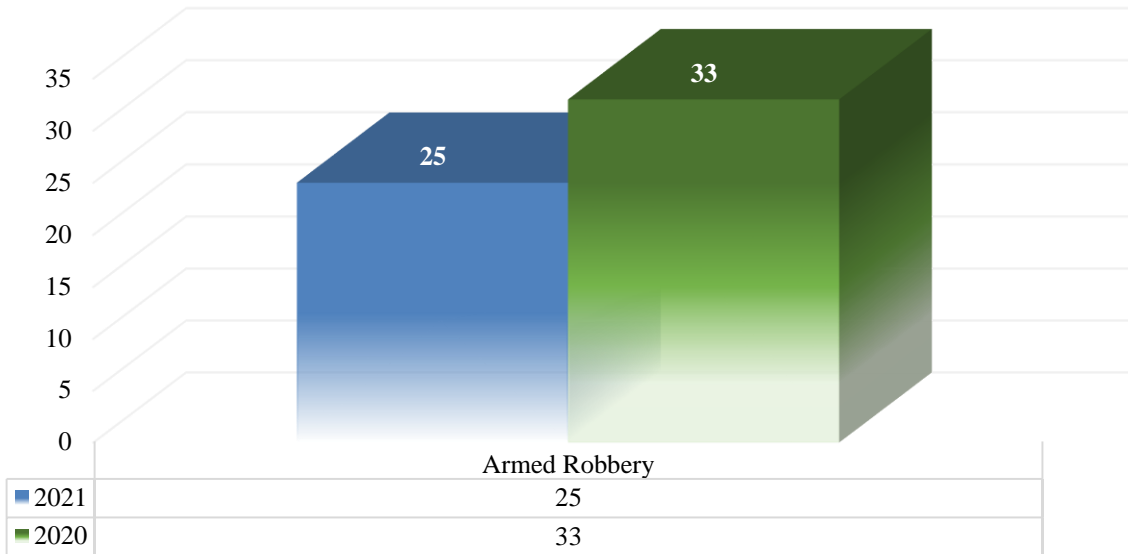

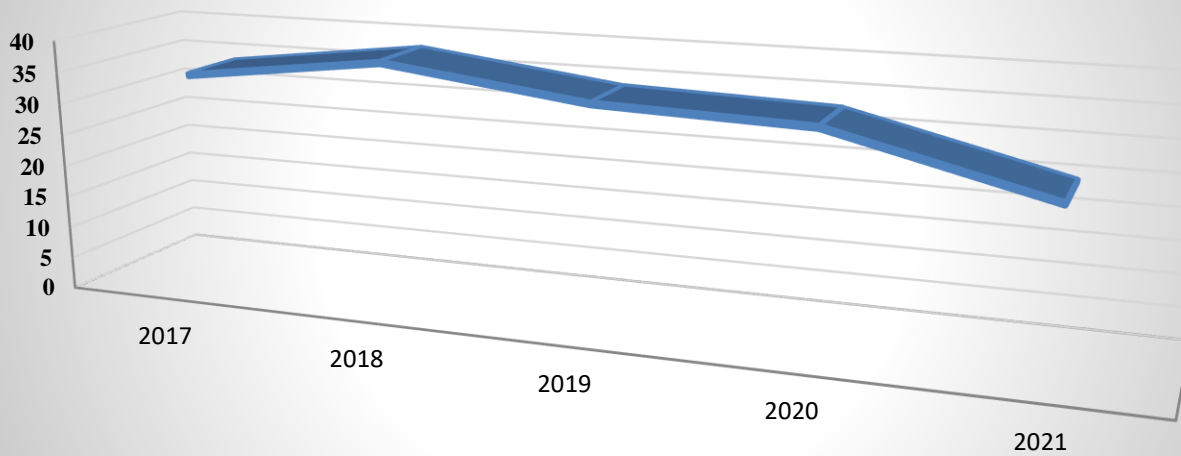
Armed Robbery

Armed Robbery February 2021 vs 2020

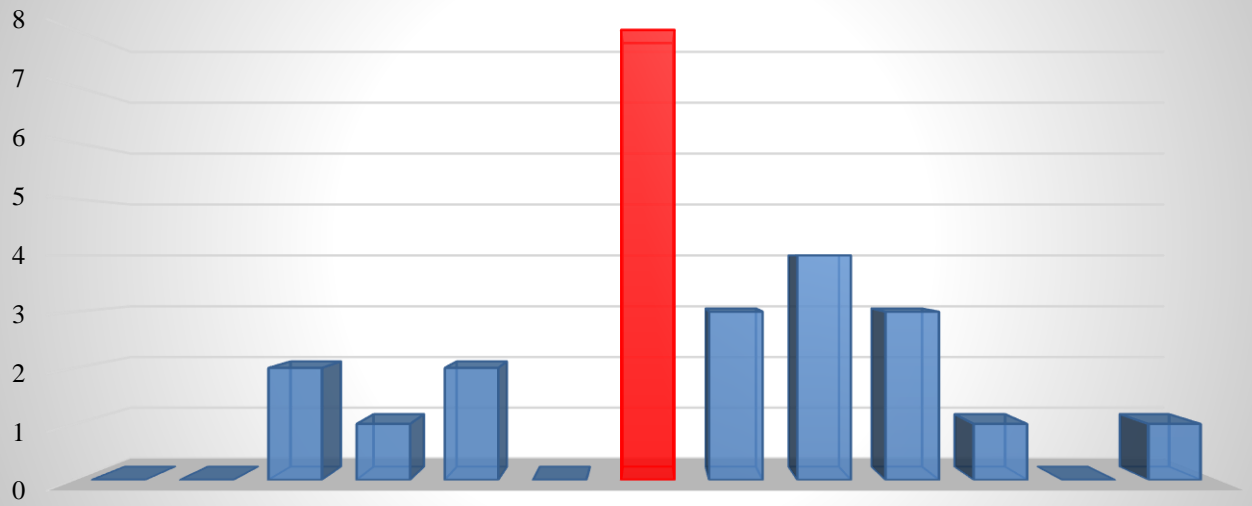


Armed Robbery February 2017 - 2021



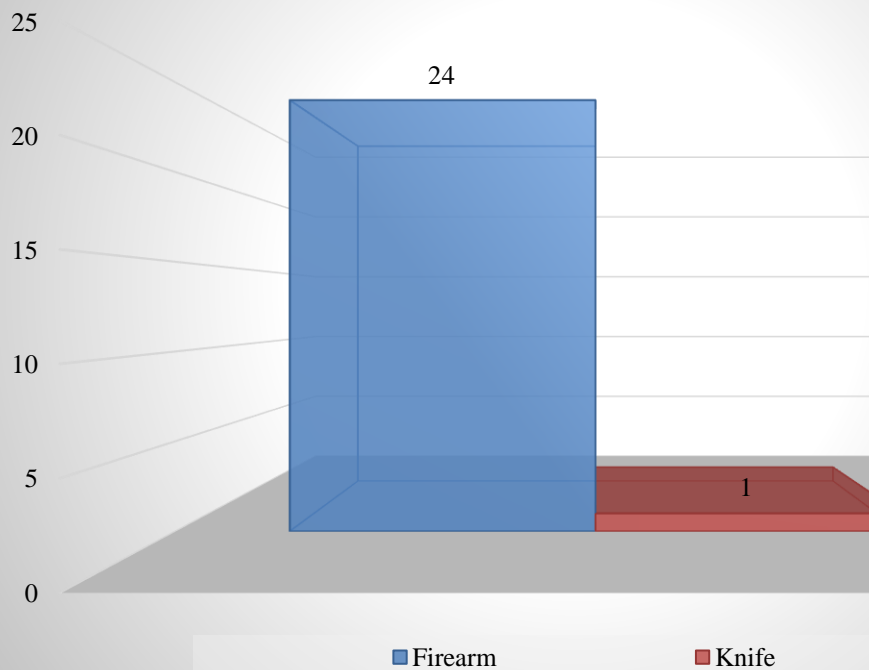

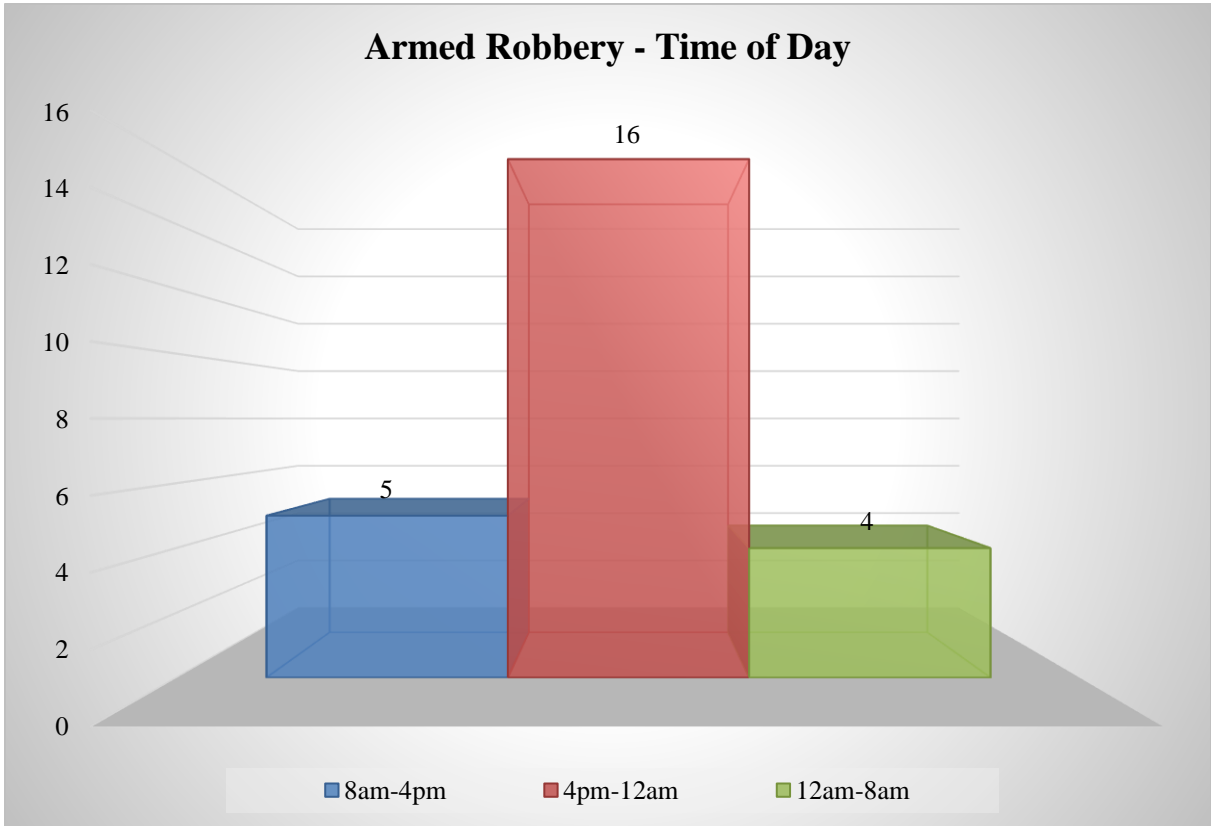
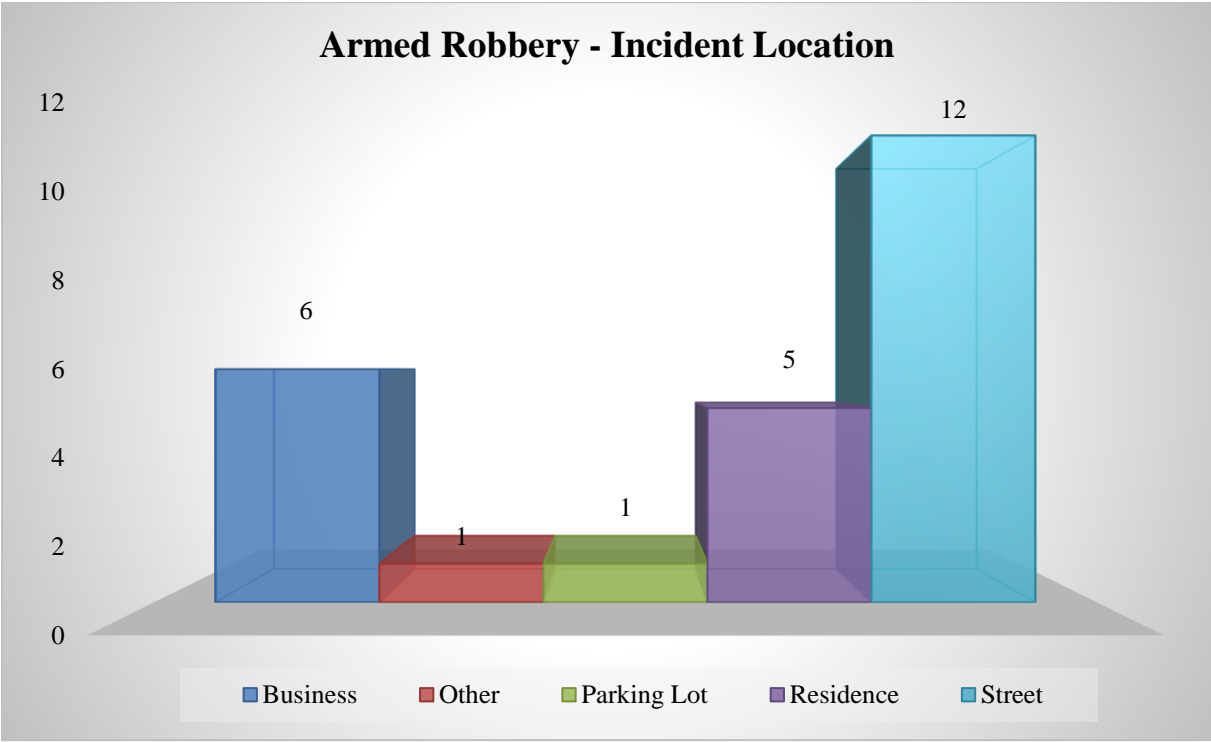
Armed Robbery - Police Division February 2021

Armed Robbery - Weapon Used February 2021

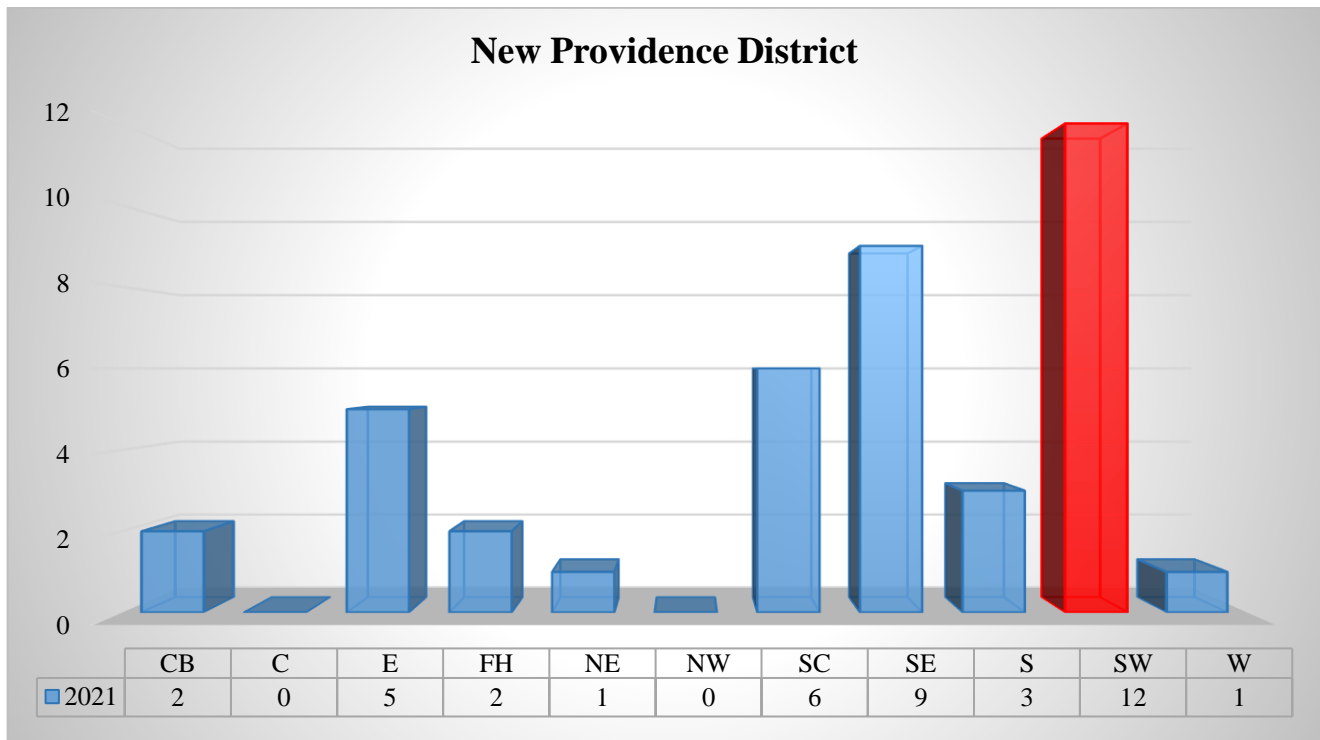
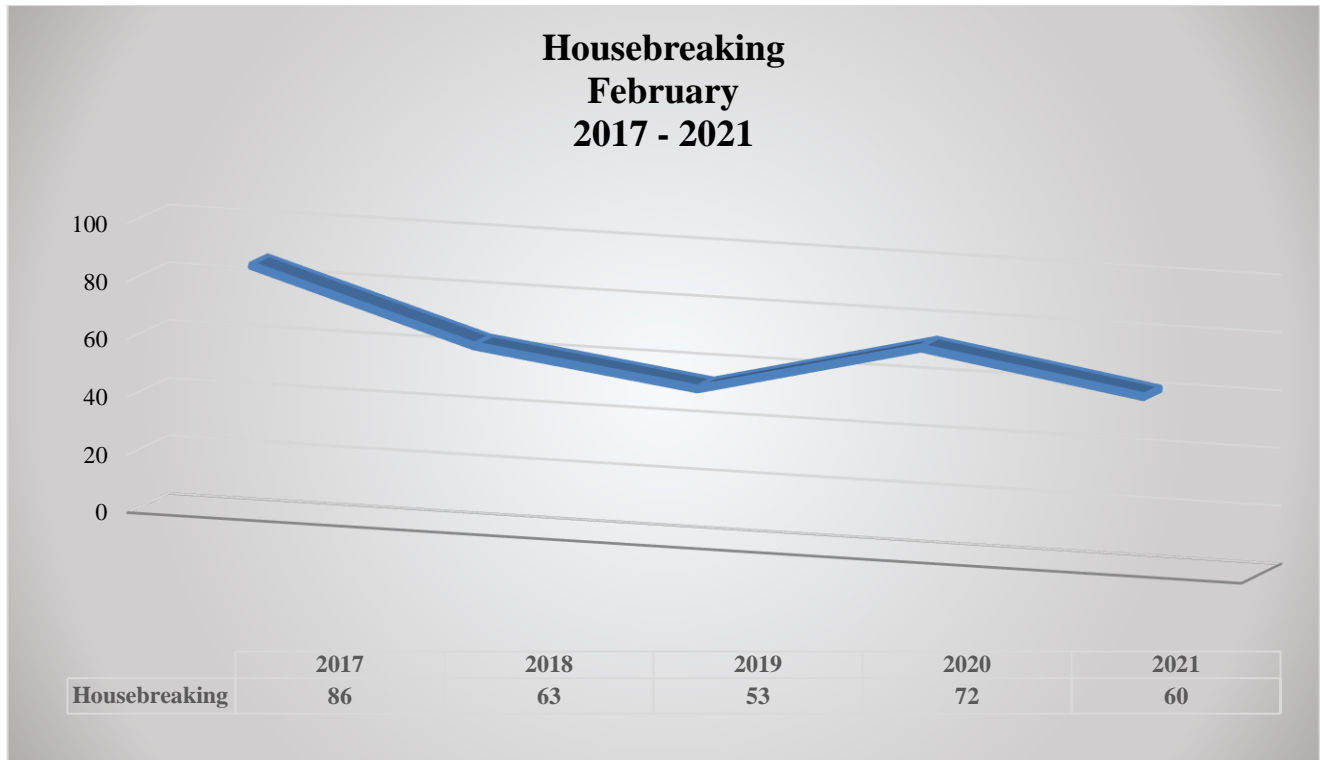




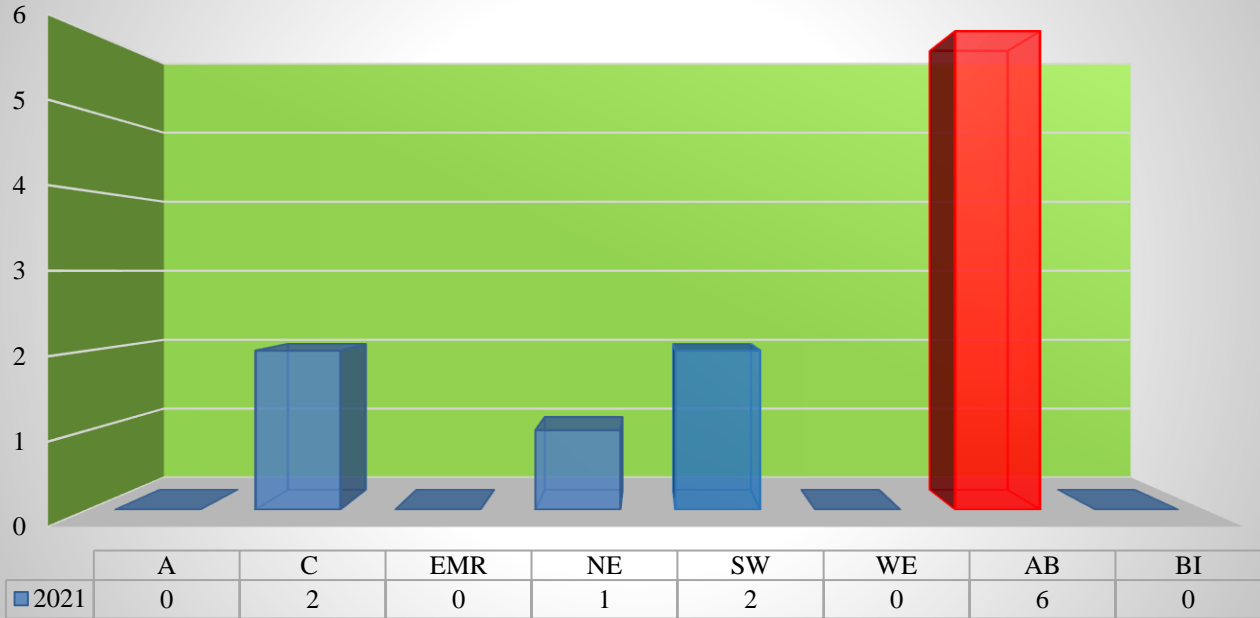

Housebreakings

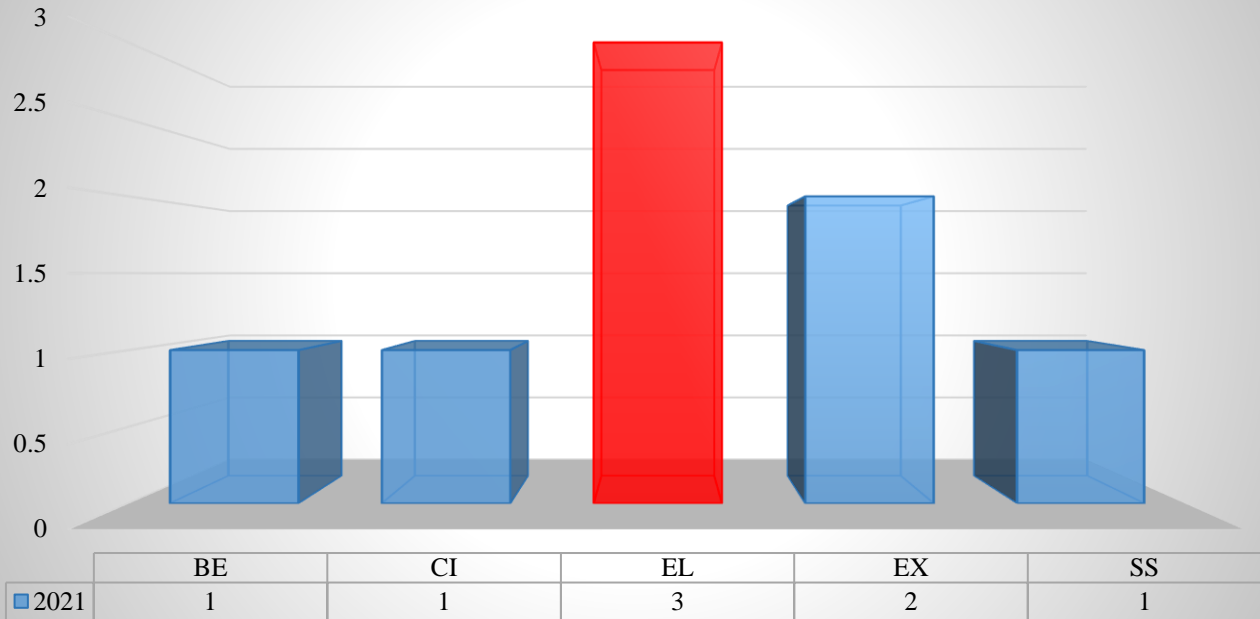

Grand Bahama District



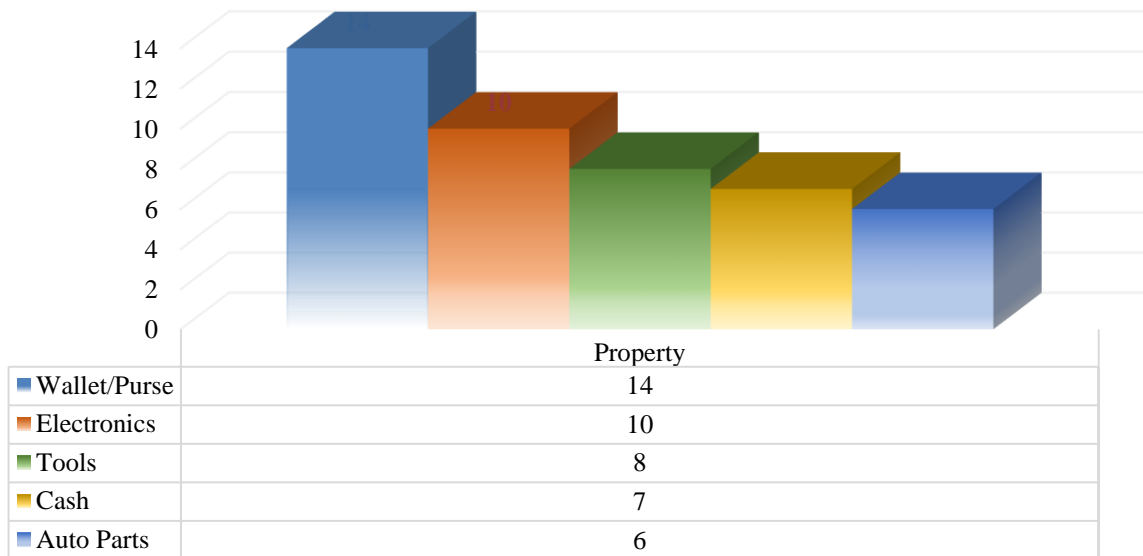
Family Islands District



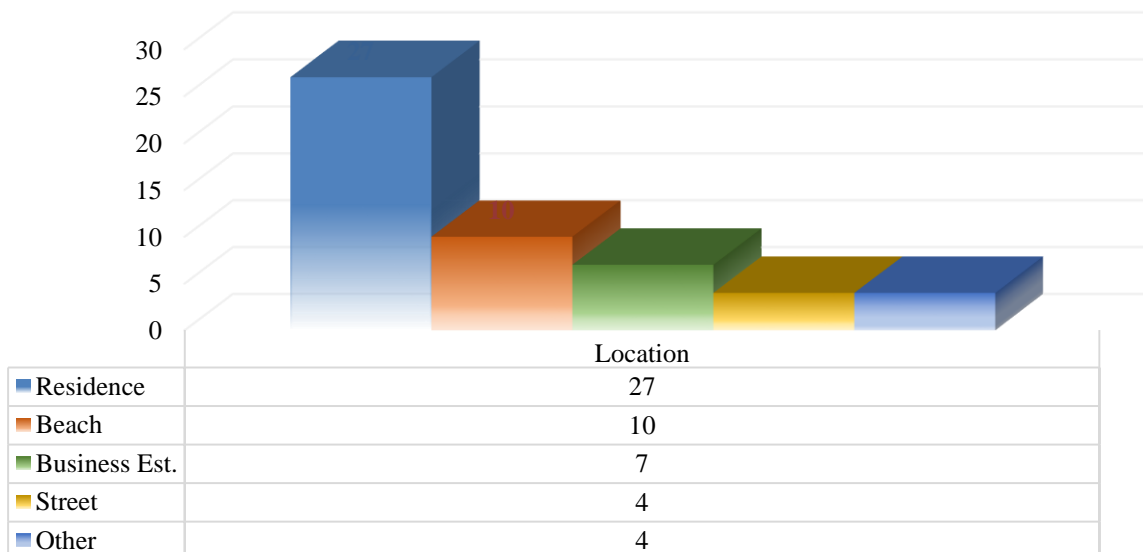
Stealing from Vehicle

Items of choice stolen from vehicles mostly consisted of wallet/purse, electronics, tools, cash and auto parts. Other items consisted of personal documents, jewelry and audio speakers. Residences and beaches were the most targeted areas for this crime representing a combined total of 71%. Other locations include cemetery and open yards. Stealing from vehicles mostly occurred with the Cable Beach division.

Stealing from Vehicle - Items Stolen February 2021

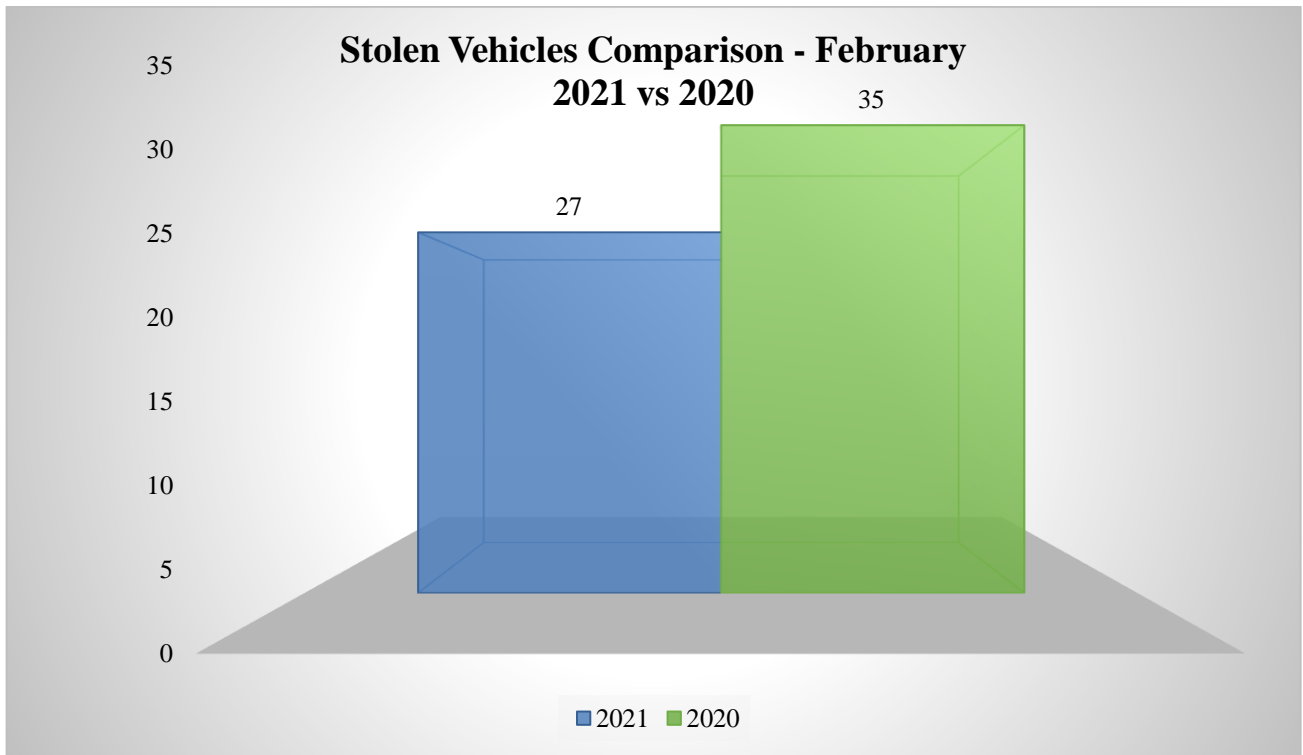


Stealing from Vehicle - Location Type February 2020

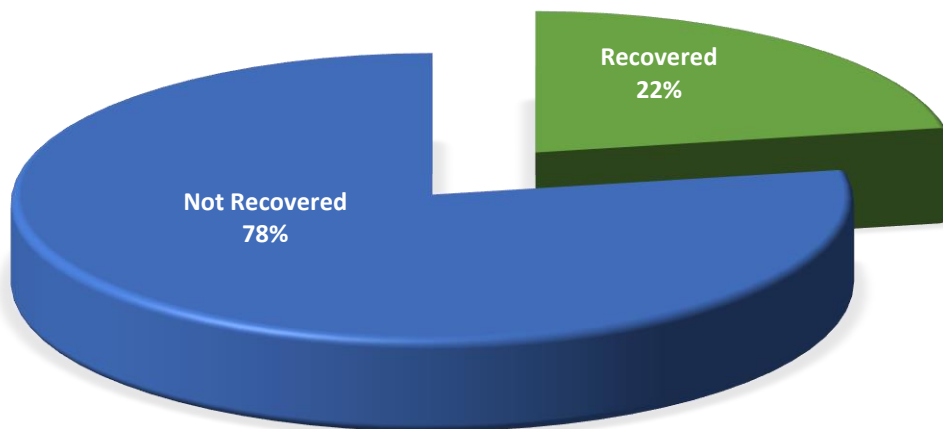


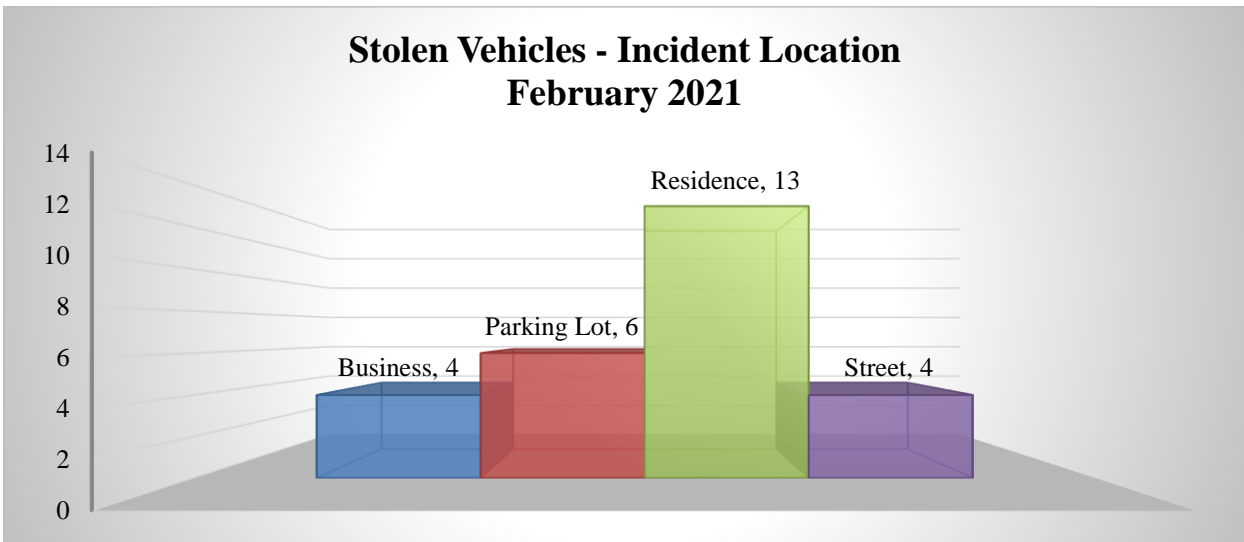
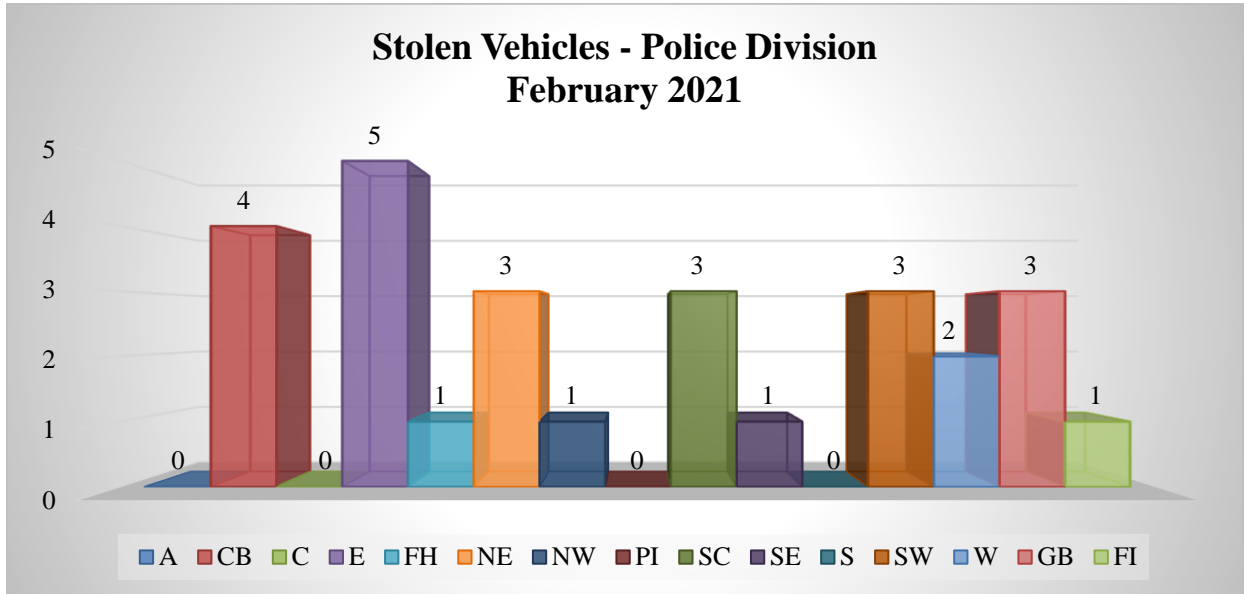
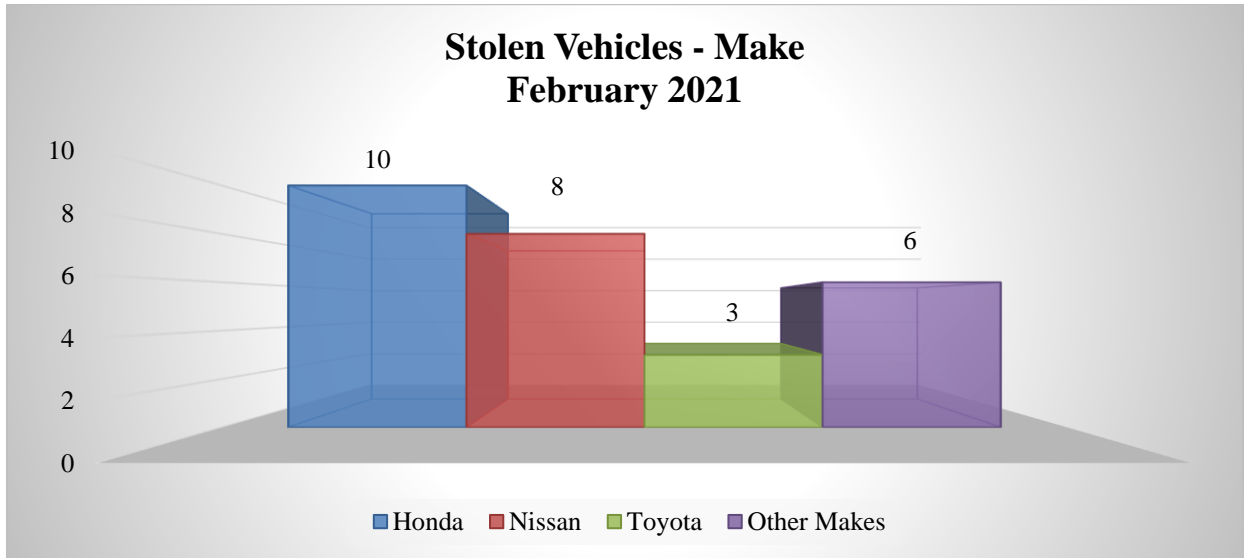
Stolen Vehicle

In February 2021, stolen vehicles decreased by 23% with 27 incidents, compared to 35 over the same period in 2020. 6 or 22% of vehicles stolen for the month were recovered.

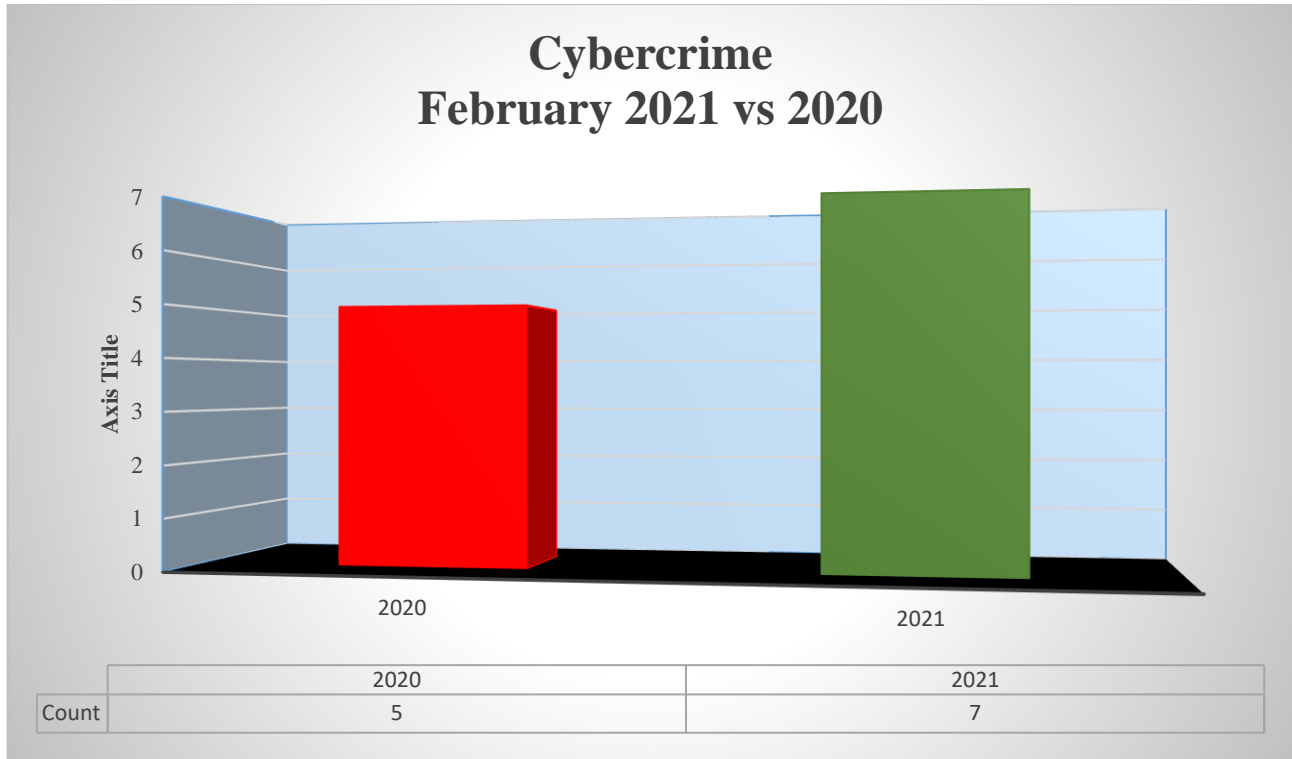

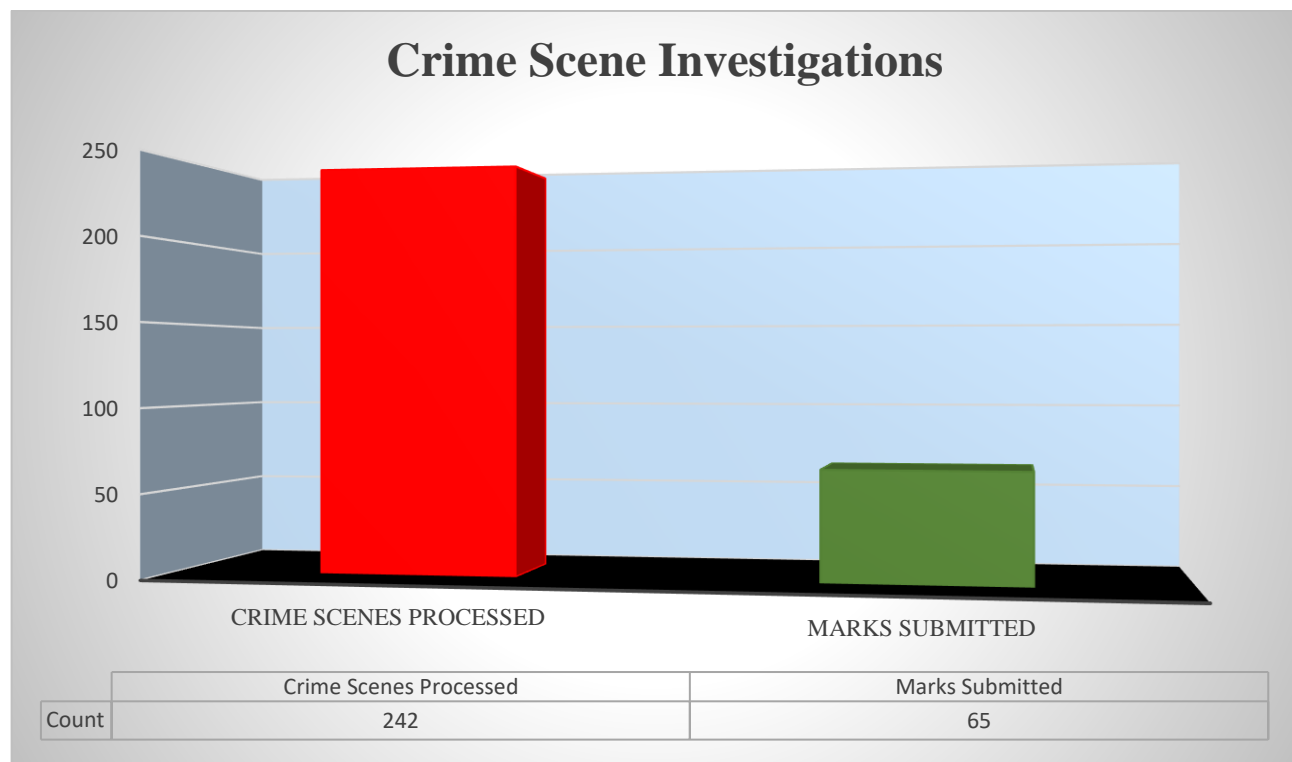
Cybercrime
